ORDINANCE NO. XXIV OF 1999

AN

ORDINANCE

*to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of
Electric Power Act, 1997*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (XL of 1997), for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

AND WHEREAS, the National Assembly and the Senate stand suspended in pursuance of the Proclamation of Emergency of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 as amended ;

AND WHEREAS, the President is satisfied that circumstances exists which render it necessary to take immediate action ;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999, as amended, as well as Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling in that behalf, the President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. **Short title, application and commencement.**—(1) This Ordinance may be called the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999.

(2) It shall apply to all appointments whether made before or after the commencement of this Ordinance.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of Section 3, Act XL of 1997.**—In the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (XL of 1997), in section 3, in sub-section (5), in the proviso for the words “not be appointed under sub-section (1) if he has already attained” the words “retire on attaining” shall be substituted.
