ISSUES OF PUBLIC HEARING IN THE MATTER OF GRANT OF LICENCE(S) FOR GENERATION AND DISTRIBUTION/SUPPLIER OF ELECTRIC POWER TO LAKE CITY MANAGEMENT (PRIVATE) LIMITED)

- (i) Under the scheme of arrangement proposed by Lake City Management (Private) Limited (LCMPL), the per unit cost of electricity using Heavy Fuel Oil fuel is likely to be higher than the average consumer end tariff of LESCO. How LCMPL will manage this difference of cost?
- (ii) Under the NEPRA Amendment Act 2018, exclusive right to distribute and sell electricity has been omitted. Whether LCMPL has taken this aspect into consideration and still intends to proceed with the applications for grant of licence(s) for generation and distribution/supplier of electric power?
