(A) Text of proposed modification

According to Article-5 of the existing generation licence (No. SGC/60/2010, dated July 30, 2010), the term of the licence was fixed for ten (10) years which will be expiring on July 29, 2020. The Company plans to get the term extended for another period of ten (10) years.

(B) Statement of reasons

The Authority fixed the original term of the generation licence based on the information provided by company on the balance operating hours of the generation facility. The company has been supplying to K Electric Limited (KEL) from this facility since 2010 and plan continuing the same for which a generation licence is a regulatory requirement and accordingly the request for extension in term of licence is being made.

(C) A statement of the impact on the tariff, quality of service and the performance by the licensee of its obligations under the licence

The proposed extension in the term of the licence will not any impact on the existing tariff determined by the Authority for supplying to KEL. Further, there will not be any adverse impact on the quality of service and obligation of the Licensee under its Licence.


