Please Note our Comments/Observations Regarding the License Application of Distribution by K-Electric, Hopefully, they will be included in your decision:

Regarding the renewal of K-Electric's distribution license by NEPRA (National Electric Power Regulatory Authority) for 20 years, it would ensure continuity and long-term planning for the power supply in Karachi. Renewal provides stability and encourages investments in infrastructure upgrades, expansion, and improvement of service quality. As per NEPRA's own State of Industry Reports KE has performed better than DISCOs and has shown a drastic reduction in T&D losses and improvement in network reliability so we would support KE's application.

However, as now KE is not asking for an exclusive license, we request NEPRA to clarify if there are two or more distribution networks operating in the same area of a city, won't it lead to several issues like:

Infrastructure Overlap: Multiple networks would require separate infrastructure installations such as substations, transformers, and power lines, leading to increased costs and visual clutter.

Inefficiency: The redundant infrastructure would result in inefficiencies in terms of resource utilization, maintenance, and coordination among different entities.

Reliability Concerns: Having multiple networks increases the risk of coordination problems and could potentially lead to power failures, disruptions, or voltage instability due to a lack of synchronization.

There needs to be a mechanism in place to avoid such a situation and will new network operators only operate in new societies and industrial zones where they buy electricity from KE or any competitive supplier in bulk and distribute further.

More importantly, will KE be allowed to surrender high-loss areas network operations so that it can become more efficient and serve it good consumers at further reduced costs?



It has been learnt that KE has applied for extension of its distribution license to prolong further its exclusivity in Karachi.



Subject: Comments on Renewal/Extension of KE Distribution License

Dear sir,

I am writing to share our comments on the request of KE's distribution license.

At the outset, we understand that due to the Amendment Act 2018, NEPRA's rules and regulations have changed and exclusivity is no longer an option that any DISCO can request for. We have been following the proceedings of other DISCOs and realized that they underwent a protracted process including 2 provisional extensions of their license before being issued non-exclusive licenses. In this regard, credit should be given to KE for compliance with the statutory requirements, which is a point that was discussed by NEPRA in the determination of each DISCO's license as well.

It is also a good point to note that NEPRA holds Distribution companies accountable for their performance at the time of the hearing. As per the publicly available information and also reported in NEPRA's State of Industry Reports and Distribution Performance Reports, KE has reduced T&D losses by 18.9% since privatization and is following other NEPRA benchmarks. The challenges in the city currently seem to be with recovery and theft of electricity, which are both influenced by macroeconomic and sociocultural conditions and perhaps may apply to the rest of the country as well.

Being an exclusive company, it was important to invest PKR 474 billion in the infrastructure since privatization, however it is equally interesting to see that the company has shared a plan of almost equal value for the upcoming years. If KE license is to be renewed, we request that the investment plan also be greenlit so that the company can further improve operationally. We must also consider that even with the CTBCM, being the owner of the network, wire business will continue to be with KE and remain regulated. Accordingly, KE will be obligated to provide its network for reliable supply of power, for which investment is necessary with clearly outlined targets.

In the same regard, it is necessary to clarify what will happen to the customers in the regulated system i.e. paying government determined rates if big industries set up their own infrastructure from the grid to their premises. I understand that the current 'competition' under the CTBCM will be between power producers seeking Bulk Power Consumers (BPC), but the network in use will belong to the respective DISCO. Would it be prudent or even efficient for an entity or group to set up a 'parallel network'? How will this link with the stranded costs and other phenomenon which are still under debate? Industrial associations are composed of a diversity of consumers and while we acknowledge the benefit to the BPCs from CTBCM, we also request to balance the interests of significant number of regulated consumers and request to provide them due clarify. Eastly, it is very important that we create a singular, consistent framework so that all customers eligible today and in the future are aware of what is coming, so that they can plan accordingly.

Dear Sir,

I would like to share my comments on K-Electric's application for renewal of Distribution License as I believe that being an industrialist, it is important that we put forward our thoughts as essential power sector stakeholders who want the best for the country at large.

Post two decades of incessant upgrades in the power sector and continued investments, we believe that K-Electric's license should be renewed which, in my view, would definitely work in the best interest of not just the industry of Karachi but also the residential commercial and other customers within the city. I also understand that the envisaged Competitive Trading Bilateral Contracts Market (CTBCM) model aims to provide eligible consumers the right to choose supplier of their choice, however, given its economics, network is perceived as a natural monopoly around the world. Some global examples can be considered as good case studies, belonging to both the developing and the developed world where it ended up becoming a win-win situation for the power sector and customers.

I believe CTBCM will create positive competition in the Power Market. Thus the consumer will get the chance to opt the best power supplier.

KE briefs its consumers it is aiming for 2030 to focus investments in sustainable renewable energy sources and promoted innovation and efficiency in the sector to lower electricity prices is remarkable plan to move ahead for sustainable future of power consumers of Karachi.

Right now, we need electricity tariffs to be cost effective and regular price hikes in utility bills is the last thing we should expect because it is crushing the underprivileged segment of the society as well as the industrial output.

In a completely non-ideal situation, should KE license not get renewed, it will not be a loss for the company alone despite previous and current investments but that for all the power consumers and a massive one indeed, irrespective of them being industrial consumers or residential which may put security and reliability of power supply at high risk. Also, if this really were to happen, KE assets would remain its property and for any new player, a power setup from scratch would take time and power the city of over 20 million. Competitive Trading Bilateral Contract Market (CTBCM) which should remain uniform throughout the country be granted to KE.

I would also like to say that there should be no parallel network in a service territory as such duplications in network would affect economies of scale and adversely impact competitiveness of small industries which could feel the pressure and be fizzled out.

Lastly, privatization is key for the power sector becoming efficient; we already have a success story in the form of KE investing PKR 474 billion since privatization and expect that it would be liberating for customers if the rest of the country followed similar suit. This could relax the circular debt and bring about relief for the national exchequer in terms of cash inflows and investments.



- i. No investment was arranged from abroad but on the other hand the Management taken huge loans from Pakistani Banks as well as the Foreign Banks, which funds were utilize for their personal requirement and not in the interest of the company affairs.
- That the tariff could not be capped as promised, but the Management have ii. approached NEPRA many a times for increase in tariff, which was allowed to them from time to time.

- 2. I would like to draw your attention to Distribution License No.24/DL/2019 granted to this Authority (LIEDA) for distribution of electricity within the authorized jurisdiction, however, KE had filed appeal in NEPRA Tribunal, Islamabad and subsequently filed case in High Court of Sindh, Karachi because of non-constitution of NEPRA Tribunal against grant of this license claiming that the area for which Disco license was granted to LIEDA falls within the licensed territory of KE despite the fact that the then KESC (now KE) had itself surrendered the distribution network to LIEDA in mid 80s owing to their incapability to handle the industrial zone in Hub, Lasbela District. The KE has deliberately gone in to litigation due to which the Disco License of this Authority is still kept it stay since its issuance.
- 3. Since LIEDA is a valid DISCO license holder as referred above for distribution of electricity within territorial limits allowed by NEPRA therefore it is requested that the territorial limits allowed to LIEDA for distribution of electricity may please be deleted from the license of KE while considering the extension of KE Disco License for a new term.







RENEWAL OF K.ELECTRIC CONTRACT

Respected Sir,

We may kindly be permitted to avail your precious time to go through the following submission with respect to the renewal of K-Electric 6 year contract for generation, transmission and distribution for electricity in Karachi.

The inhabitants of the City Of Quaid are facing hardship for the poor performance, over billing, announced and unannounced load shedding and frequent power failures at the bequest of M/S K-Electric for almost two decades. It appears that the renewal of K-Electric's license for the period 2024-2030 is under consideration in the Ministry Of Energy and NEPRA. It would be in the fitness of things and in the interest of justice that the Ministry and Regulatory Authority should analyse the performance of K-Electric in the following manner before taking any decision:

How far has K-Electric fulfilled its commitments regarding announcement of power generation and maintaing electric tariff in the original contract.

How, K-Electric has utilised the subsidy offered by the Government Of Pakistan from time to time during the last two decades for the improvement of their system and providing facilities to the consumers.

How far does K-Electric stand by their promises and assurances with respect to the time limit of load shedding in various categories of areas given to the honourable courts and Regulatory Authority. The record can be checked from NEPRA files.

- d-The number of complaints registered against K-Electric in the secretariat of Federal Ombudsman, NEPRA and the Electric Inspector.
- Does K-Electric avail the facility of independent third party laboratory for examining the ecomplaints of faulty meter as well the meter reading.
- f-Does K-Electric pay rent to the concerned authorities for their installation, spread all over the city of Karachi.
- What quantum of power generation is increased by K-Electric during the last two decades. g-
- What statistics can K-Electric offer for the concrete efforts and material improvement in htransmission and distribution network in Karachi.
- The kind and amount of income that K-Electric has spent yearly on Corporate Social Responsibility(CSR).
 - How far K-Electric has facilitated the Collective Bargaining Agent of company's employees. How far did K-Electric fail to perform its ownership responsibilities and outsourced its essential functions to the third party at the cost of fundamental human rights and service to the consumers.

- K- The consumers of electricity in Karachi have, time and again, rejected the electric product. Recently, the citizens of Karachi have commented adversely on the 'K-Electric Investment Plan' offered on NEPRA's website. The consumers are unwilling and don't want K-Electric product. Thus, K-Electric product can justifiably be not imposed or thrusted on the consumers forcibly by the state.
- I- The ownership of company/sponsor's shares or even majority shares cannot qualify K-Electric for the grant of renewal of their license for the next 6 years. It is the moral obligation of 'State' to serve the interests and welfare of consumers against any odd. Welfare of public is the paramount law.
- m- No civilized and law abiding society can restrict the choice of consumer / costumers / buyer to use / buy only a particular product. In case of K-Electric, citizens have no choice but to avail a single product on claimed cost / price.
- n- The poor performance of K-Electric has adversely hitted private corporate industrial and business sector in Karachi and as a result thereof the export and trade activity has to bear irreparable loss in the shape of foreign exchange earnings.
- o- The only achievement which K-Electric can claim was the replacement of costly and reliable copper wire with cheaper and inferior quality of sliver wiring. The impact of replacement of wiring has to be examined by Environment Protection Agency.

The Government Of Pakistan, Ministry Of Energy and NEPRA should take into account the image and prestige that K-Electric earns within and outside Pakistan when the owner of M/S Obraj Capitals Mr. Masood Naqvi is facing serious criminal trial in United Kingdom and most probably in United States in the coming days. What would be the impact of such a derogatory situation if K-Electric's license is renewed in Pakistan. Will it not hurt the reputation and honour of the Islamic Republic Of Pakistan.

The Government Of Pakistan, Ministries Of Energy, Finance, Commerce, Planning and Environment as well as NEPRA and SECP are under the obligation to examine the possibility of engaging several other companies for power supply in the highly dense and populated city and the financial hub of the country 'Karachi' in order to encourage the environment of competition both for the improvement of quality and price of the product in the larger interest of the country. If other power management companies are facilitated of bidding in the electricity supply, it would eventually be a potential source of foreign exchange in this hour of need. It may also be appreciated that 'monopoly' in private sector is a curse on the society. The monopoly of State in the supplies of utilities can, however be adjusted as in the rest of the country. We understand that the process of comparative evaluation will be followed in determining the future course of action.

The Pakistan Civic Society(PCS) expects that the above submissions will be sympathetically considered and accordingly entertained in the wider national interest. Thanking and assuring you of our highest consideration.

2. The matter has been examined at length and revealed as under:-

(a) NEPRA is empowered under the relevant Act to exclusively regulate the provision of electric power services in the country. The powers and functions of NEPRA as delineated in the Act including specification of № Procedures and Standards for investment programmes by Generation Companies; enforcement of performance standards for Generation Companies; review of its own order, decisions or determinations; determination of tariff, rates, charges and other terms and conditions for supply of electric power services by the companies. It also has authority to review Organizational Affairs of Generation Companies to avoid any adverse effect on the operations of electronic power services in order to have continuous and efficient supply of such services, these sweeping powers fully enable NEPRA to evaluate the performance of Karachi Electric Limited (KEL) and to take appropriate decision regarding renewal of the license of the Agency.

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- (b) There are strong arguments both for and against, in respect of renewal of Distribution License of KEL and stakes are very high. Reportedly, NEPRA had already called public opinion in this context and a public hearing(s) would be fixed very soon. The final decision will be taken by NEPRA before the expiry of the KEL's license.
- 3. In view of the position explained above, all the above complaints are forwarded to NEPRA for disposal under their Dispute Resolution Mechanism on merit. Complainants are advised to submit their view in the public hearing arranged by NEPRA.

2. The representatives of Agency (NEPRA) submitted a clubbed report for all cases reproduced as under:-

"all stakeholders, interested/affected persons and general public have been invited vide public notice advertised on May 06, 2023 to submit their comments in favour or against the proposal of KEL for renewal/extension in terms of Distribution License within fourteen (14) days of the publication of notice. In view of the above, the applicant has submitted their comments which have been forwarded to the Registrar, NEPRA."

3. The representatives of Agency (K-Electric) submitted a report reproduced as under:

"It is submitted that K-Electric is the only privatized vertically integrated power utility company in Pakistan, having all three licenses from NEPRA for Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electricity. KE is currently under the process of renewal of its Distribution license from the regulatory authority i.e. NEPRA. Additionally, KE along with its Distribution license renewal request has laso submitted an investment plan with PKR 484 billion for its Transmission and Distribution businesses for period 2024-2030.

Since privatization and upto FY 2022, KE has invested PKR 474 billion across the power value chain. However, despite exemplary performance of KE over the years, it is unfortunate to observe that some individuals are seeking cancellation of KE's Distribution license, for which they have approached this Honorable Secretariat by filing frivolous complaints mentioning false/misleading facts and figures against KE, which is unjustified in light of previous history and performance of KE post privatization including but not limited to:

- Reduction in T&D losses from 34.2% in FY 2005 to 15.3% in FY 2002 (reduction of 18.9% points)
- Increase in overall recovery ratio to 96.7% in FY 2002 through targeted recovery drives and measures.
- Reduction in AT&C losses from 36.6% in FY 2005 to 18.1% in FY 2022 (reduction of 18.5% points)
- Upgradation of network and capacity enhancement through addition of:

Over 20,000 Pole Mounted Transformers (PMT) and 4,803 MVA in distribution capacity (from 3,882 MVA in FY 2005 to 8,685 MVA in FY 2002)

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Over 1,000 11KV feeders increasing the total number of 11KV feeders to 2,001 in FT 2022.

It is humbly submitted that KE's application for renewal is filed before NEPRA in line with applicable regulatory framework. Further, in accordance with the due process of law, NEPRA has published a public notice to invite comments on KE's request to renew its distribution license for another 20 years on the basis of its past performance and future investments.

In view of foregoing, KE humbly requests the learned forum that since the instant matter is already under consideration before another competent forum i.e. NEPRA whereas due process is already in place for evaluation of KE's request for renewal of its Distribution License, therefore, it is humbly requested that the complainants may be advised to pursue their complaints with respect to the subject matter before NEPRA for effective redressal of their grievances in accordance with law, as this Honorable forum/authority does not have the jurisdiction to entertain such complainants."

4. The above mentioned forty complaints were investigated to determine Agency's maladministration as per Article 2 (2) of President's Order No. 1 of 1983. Final hearing of the above cases was held on 07.06.2023 in presence of representatives of NEPRA (Mr. Abid Hussain, Advisor), K-Electric (Mr. Aamir Shehzad, G.M. Distribution Legal and Mr. Najam, DGM) and the following three complainants who expressed their view:-

The remaining complainants did not attend hearing despite notices, SMSs sent through CMIS and telephone calls.

- 5. During the hearing, the above mentioned three complainants pleaded that the advertisement issued by NEPRA calling comments from consumers/general public for renewal/extension of Distribution License of K-Electric, within 14 days was published in the newspaper on 06.05.2023. Only a very meager numbers of consumers, both institutions as well as individuals might have responded to this advertisement but as a matter of fact millions of consumers who had not read the above mentioned advertisements were left without expressing their grievance for consideration of stake-holders while considering renewal of Distribution License of K-Electric. The time of 14 days given to file objection has also expired. Further reservation expressed by the complainants are as under :-
 - Load-shedding/power outage particularly during summer months in most of i) the areas of Karachi Metropolitan continues from eight to sixteen hours per day which severely upset the life cycle of the people and business. This is mainly due to less generation/distribution of electricity as compared to the demand, as well defective distribution system beside K-electric's own policy of load shedding. The K-Electric has not invested sufficiently to enhance the generation and improvement of distribution network.
 - During winter months and also in cases of particularly rented houses which ii) some time remain unoccupied for months together, the bills of K-Electric, obviously drop but K-Electric attribute the low billing as a result of theft of in discriminately impose heavy fines irregular/supplementary bills (IRB) against such consumers and disconnect electricity supply in case of failure to pay the huge fines. The K-Electric never allowed any concession in fine (IRB). The only remedy remains to approach the office of Wafaqi Mohtasib or NEPRA which is availed by a very small number of consumers due to ignorance while consumers have to pay the huge fines to K-Electric in order to restore their electric supply. This is height of injustice and high-handedness by K-Electric which should be properly addressed while renewing the Distribution License of K-Electric.
 - The K-Electric has not made adequate investment to replace the out dated iii) electric installations and distribution network resulting in very poor supply and frequent outage particularly during Summer season which make the life miserable. This is despite the fact that K-Electric is earning considerable profit every year at the cost of worries faced by the consumers. While renewing the Distribution License of K-Electric, NEPRA should fix conditions for a certain percentage of investment per annum by K-electric for improvement of Distribution system and other installation as well as additional generation of electricity to meet the increasing demand of Karachi Metropolitan.

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- iv) It was also suggested that keeping in view the performance of K-Electric its Distribution License should not be renewed for twenty years but for a lesser period in order to check the performance of K-Electric and also giving opportunity of healthy competition with other market players, in order to apply a positive check on monopoly enjoyed by K-Electric in this filed.
- v) The complainants further stated that particularly in Katchi Abadi's, in connivance of the K-Electric staff, an organized kunda system exists which creates problem to the adjacent areas for poor supply of electricity. The K-Electric has not been able to check their own staff involved in mal-practices.
- vi) The complainant further requested that while finalizing the Renewal/Extension of Distribution License of K-Electric, the NEPRA should publish the final statement of terms of conditions addressing the public grievance on which basis the agreement is being made with K-Electric, for public information and record.
- by DISCOS. For example for a certain number of units, the bills assessed by DISCO, Islamabad is much lesser than bill assessed for the same number of units by K-Electric. As a matter of policy of the government is bound to charge uniform rates, but it is not understood as to how K-Electric is allowed to charge higher tariffs as compared to DISCOs. This discrepancy by addressed properly while renewing of Distribution of License of K-Electric is considered.
- viii) The complainants expressed thanks to Wafaqi Mohtasib for providing opportunity to express their grievances at this important forum and expected their submission will be assigned due importance while finalizing the case of extension of Distribution of K-Electric by NEPRA.
- 6. Responding the complainants views, Mr. Aamir Shehzad, General Manager, K-Electric stated that:
 - i) K-Electric is providing electric utility to about 3.6 million consumers including industrial, agriculture and commercial sectors besides domestic consumers. The K-Electric was inherited very limited generation un-capacity and a completely dilapidated Distribution Network and installations which the K-Electric improved by making investment of about PKR 474 billion till now. The K-Electric has a further plan of investment of PKR 484 billion during 2024-2030 to further improve the Generation and Distribution System.
 - ii) There were huge line losses and theft of electricity which were controlled to a reasonable extent with the efforts of the K-Electric. The K-Electric also inherited a very poorly equipped and surplus work force which was improved into an organized and professional work forces during the past years by K-Fleetric which is maintaining supply of Electric utility by K-Electric.

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- iii) Due to persistent increase in population and expansion vertical development of city limit the demand for new connections is also increasing fast which needed more generation and hiring the electric supply from other sources to which the K-Electric is properly handling and catering the increasing requirements of the city dwellers.
- iv) K-Electric never opposed inception of more market players in the business of Generation and Distribution System in Karachi.
- v) K-Electric is facing problem in certain areas where organized electricity theft is made and K-electric staff going for disconnection of hooks are threatened of dire consequences by unscrupulous elements responsible for organized theft of electricity.
- vi) K-Electric strictly observe relevant conditions of Consumer Service Manual of NEPRA while dealing with case of extra phase/hook installed by consumer for assessment of irregular bills to recover the loss caused to K-Electric.
- vii) The representative of Agency further added that since last about sevenyear K-Electric has introduced more than five relief schemes to allow concessions upto 90% of the dues of huge amounts outstanding against the concerned consumers. The K-Electric has mentioned address, phone number and website of NEPRA and Wafaqi Mohtasib in their bills so that the consumers not satisfied with K-Electric may approach NEPRA or Wafaqi Mohtasib for redressal of their grievances. The K-Electric implemented all cases decided by NEPRA or Wafaqi Mohtasib resolving the grievances of the complainants.
- 7. Responding the complainants' views the representative of NEPRA stated that that vide their letter No.NEPRA/R/LAD-01/2-439-44 dated 21.04.2021, the NEPRA has already intimated that "the authority (NEPRA) has also offered an opportunity to stake-holders present physically at the place of public hearing as well as to those who decide to join online through ZOM facility, to express their views relating to the issue of renewal/extension of Distribution license of K-Electric."
 - i. So far as the point of the complainants regarding addition of more players in business of Distribution of Power for Karachi is concerned, the NEPRA has already taken care. In its policy circular dated 21.4.2021, it has been mentioned that:-
 - "The NEPRA Act was amended on May 02, 2018 vide the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power (Amendment) Act, 2018 (XII of 2018) (the "Amendment Act") introducing significant changes in the relevant market structure to bring market reforms with the objectives to encourage participation by more market players to enhance efficiently and to ensure better price, quality of service and choice for the consumers of electricity. "
 - ii. The authority (NEPRA) is looking to the market position and anticipate more market players to come up with investment plan for establishment of electricity generation and distribution entrepreneur in Karachi which would obviously redress the implications of monopoly enjoyed by K-Electric atpresent.

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- iii. The representative of the NEPRA further stated that apart from calling objections through newspapers, the NEPRA will also hold public hearing before finalizing the case of further extension of the Distribution License of K-Electric for which notices will be issued through leading newspapers. The complainants and other interested consumers may attend public hearing and further explain their view before the authority (NEPRA) personally or through ZOM facility.
- iv. Replying to the demand for appropriate investment to be made by K-Electric, it was explained that K-Electric has already submitted an Integrated investment Plan for FY 24 FY30 availing to PKR 484 billion which can be down loaded from NEPRA Website.
- 8. After a thorough discussion, it was revealed that the case of renewal/extension of Distribution License of K-Electric is being handled by NEPRA under the rules and policy. During the hearing, sufficient opportunity was given to the complainants to convey their views for consideration of the authority (NEPRA) while considering renewal/extension of Distribution License of K-Electric. Representatives of K-Electric as well as NEPRA noted the issues raised by the complainants during the hearing. The Wafaqi Mohtasib (Ombudsman) has no role in renewal/extension of Distribution License of K-Electric which is the exclusive domain of NEPRA for which the NEPRA has already made appropriate arrangements under their rules and policy and have noted the reservations expressed by the complainants in the hearing in Wafaqi Mohtasib Secretariat. NEPRA will also hold separate public hearing in this regard after publicizing the date, time and venue through print and electronic media. The complainant and other interested persons may attend such personal hearing session organized by NEPRA to ventilate their views.
- 9. The investigation of the above complaints are closed under Regulation 23(1)(z) of the Wafaqi Mohtasib (Investigation and Disposal of Complaints) Regulations, 2013.

Subject: Comments on Renewa!/Extension of KE Distribution License

Dear Sir,

We are writing to share our comments on the request of KE's distribution license.

At the outset, we understand that due to the Amendment Act 2018, NEPRA's rules and regulations have changed and exclusivity is no longer an option that any DISCO can request for. We have been following the proceedings of other DISCOs and realized that they underwent a protracted process including 2 provisional extensions of their license before being issued non-exclusive licenses. In this regard, credit should be given to KE for compliance with the statutory requirements, which is a point that was discussed by NEPRA in the determination of each DISCO's license as well.

It is also a good point to note that NEPRA holds Distribution companies accountable for their performance at the time of the hearing. As per the publicly available information and also reported in NEPRA's State of Industry Reports and Distribution Performance Reports, KE has reduced T&D losses by 18.9% since privatization and is following other NEPRA benchmarks. The challenges in the city currently seem to be with recovery and theft of electricity, which are both influenced by macroeconomic and sociocultural conditions and perhaps may apply to the rest of the country as well.

Being an exclusive company, it was important to invest PKR 474 billion in the infrastructure since privatization, however it is equally interesting to see that the company has shared a plan of almost equal value for the upcoming years. If KE license is to be renewed, we request that the investment plan also be greenlit so that the company can further improve operationally. We must also consider that even with the CTBCM, being the owner of the network, wire business will continue to be with KE and remain regulated. Accordingly, KE will be obligated to provide its network for reliable supply of power, for which investment is necessary with clearly outlined targets.

In the same regard, it is necessary to clarify what will happen to the customers in the regulated system i.e. paying government determined rates if big industries set up their own infrastructure from the grid to their premises. We understand that the current 'competition' under the CTBCM will be between power producers seeking Bulk Power Consumers (BPC), but the network in use will belong to the respective DISCO. Would it be prudent or even efficient for an entity or group to set up a 'parallel network'? How will this link with the stranded costs and other phenomenon which are still under debate? Industrial associations are composed of a diversity of consumers and while we acknowledge the benefit to the BPCs from CTBCM, we also request to balance the interests of significant number of regulated consumers and request to provide them due clarity. Lastly, it is very important that we create a singular,

consistent framework so that all customers eligible today and in the future are aware of what is coming, so that they can plan accordingly.
