Subject: Application of Ittehad Pvt Ltd Power Limited for the Grant of Power Supply License

This is in continuation to your letter No. NEPRA/R/LAS-100/37827, dated December 04, 2023 wherein it has been informed that the Federal Govt. has notified the eligibility criteria rules for the Supplier License on September 09, 2023. In view of the said, it has been directed that we are required to submit the certain information/documents in respect of our subject application.

(2). In consideration of the above, we will like to clarify that we had set up a 4.563 MW natural gas fuel based generation facility which supplies specifically to a designated consumer/Bulk Power Consumer-BPC in the name of Ittehad Textile Pvt Ltd (ITPL) and Ittehad Fabrics Pvt Ltd. (IFPL). In this regard, it is pertinent to mention that the said generation facility is working at 440 voltages and supplying through dedicated feeders to the sister organizations. Further to the said, we have reviewed to the various provisions of the high level design and detailed design of the CTBCM, National Electricity Policy/Plan and the provisions of the Eligibility Criteria Rules that the Federal Govt. has prescribed for the supplier license. In this regard, it is submitted that all the requirements enshrined in the notified rules pertains to a generating company/facility being in central dispatch operated by a System Operator and supplying to a distinctly located BPC through own network without using the network of NTDC or DISCO.

(3). In view of the above, it is submitted that the requirements of the Eligibility Criteria Rules are not applicable in our case. In order to have more clarity we have tabulated the requirements communicated and our observations in the matter the review of the same will strengthen our position in this regard. In view of the above, it is submitted that processing of our pending application be expedite.

(4). A List of the required documents is attached herewith for your reference, and clarity sheet has also been attached for further requirements.

1 generation facility
Ittehad (Pvt) Ltd., 1km Jaranwala Road Khurianwala, Faisalabad, has been operating 4.563 MW Captive power plants since 2005 with SNGPL approved captive power plant gas connection.

After government of Pakistan (NEECA) requirement for efficient co-generation power plants, Ittehad (Pvt) Ltd. has replaced the existing 05 Nos. of WAUKESHA 900 KW gas engines, Sp fuel consumption 0.34 m³/KWh, the less efficient engines with New German MTU efficient gas engines (03 x 1.5 MW), has the sp fuel consumption 0.254 m³/KWh, electrical efficiency 44.4%, with heat recovery and Chiller option.

The new MTU gas engines were reached at site in September 30, 2021, were delayed due to covid19 (MTU letter attached for reference), and erection work was completed in December 22, 2021. (RA Engineering, MTU Local Representative in Pakistan, letter attached for reference)

As per SNGPL Letter no FS/1054/IND dated: 06-02-2018 our gas load enhanced 1.050 MMSCFD from 0.95 MMSCFD and now Ittehad Pvt Ltd total gas Allocation is 2 MMSCFD for replaced new gen sets.

It is pertinent to mention that IPL, IFPL and ITPL are associated companies of the group but are separate legal entities registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP).

1 generation facility
As per existing regulatory regime, IPL *has acquired* a generation license and an authorization from the Authority for supplying to the said entities as Bulk Power Consumers [BPC(s)] as stipulated in Section 22 of the NEPRA Act. It is pertinent to mention that the CPP *generation facility* and the proposed BPC(s) are located across a service road (Mostly used for Ittehad group of companies) a public property.

generation facility
In order to connect that CPP and BPC(s), underground cables will be laid which will cross the said public property. We are aware that the Authority previously had allowed similar arrangement for many entities including Bhanero Energy Limited, Nishat Mills Limited, NC Electric Limited and Gul Ahmad Textile Mills Limited, the same arrangement may also be allowed in our case.

Un-interrupted Electrical Power is essential for running machinery in factories and industrial units. There has been an enormous increase in the demand of Electrical energy in the last two decades due to industrial Development, but sadly, there has been no significant improvement in efficient energy distribution system. Keeping in view the above, Ittehad Pvt Ltd Group has decided to set-up 4.563 MW Gas based combined Cycle power project which will be sufficient enough to fulfill the energy requirements of the Ittehad Pvt Ltd. and Ittehad Fabrics Pvt Ltd and Ittehad Textile Pvt Ltd i.e. sister organizations.

The proposed power plant is located in Ittehad Pvt Ltd. adjacent to **Ittehad Fabrics Pvt Ltd**, the weaving unit and **Ittehad Textile Pvt Ltd**, The processing unit, with main configuration of 3 x 1.521 MW MTU Rolls Royce gas based Gen sets. One 1 x 2.6 t/h exhaust heat recovery boiler, with steam temp 180 degree C. Annual operation hours are set as >8000 hours based on the availability of Gas Supply from SNGPL. Outgoing feeder voltage of generator is 440 V. Supply power is 300 KW depends on the power requirement of sister organizations.

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF
ITTEHAD (PRIVATE) LIMITED.

- I. The name of the Company is "ITTEHAD (PRIVATE) LIMITED"
- II. The Registered Office of the Company shall be situated in the Province of Punjab.
- III. The objects for which the Company is established are:-
 1. To establish and set up Cloth processing unit for the purpose of printing dyeing and bleaching of cloth.
 2. To establish and set-up weaving Factory.
 3. To carry on the business of weavers, knitters, combers spinners hosiery manufacturers of fine textile, hosiery fabrics, embroidery fabrics of all kinds and description, readymade garments, silk and man-made fabrics of all kinds and description.
 4. To carry on the business of Cloth merchants and to deal in all kinds of cloth.
 5. To carry on the business of import and export of all goods, items, commodities, articles and products.
 6. To establish and set-up an Embroidery Factory.
 7. To erect, maintain, alter, extend, modernize, re-model or otherwise establish, own manage and run various kinds of mills, factories and works, undertake and execute any contract for works involving the supply or use of any machinery and to carry out the auxiliary or other works, comprised of such works.
 8. To carry on the business of oil extraction by mechanical or chemical process from cotton seed, mustard, castor-peanuts any other oil producing substances processing and preparing any by-products and generally to manufacture, refine, prepare, and deal in all kinds of oil.
 9. To purchase take on lease or otherwise acquire agricultural lands for agricultural purposes and/or for establishing model farms
 10. To set up, establish, own, operate, acquire, run and manage processing plants and canning factories for processing, preserving packing and canning shrimps, fish, fruits, vegetable and other edible products for human and animal consumption; and to deal in all kinds of machinery appliances and materials for achieving the objects and to import, export or deal with the same.

11. To act as manufactures, representatives, producers, representatives, agents, selling agents, buying agents, managers, brokers, commission agents, indenters, indenting agents, canvassers, advertisers, stockists, distributors, for any persons, firms or companies, clearing agents, lighteners, insurance agents, for mercantile agents, forwarding agents, inspectors, importers, exporters, advisors, consultants, controllers, engineers, secretaries, concessionaries mine owners, property agents, auctioners and re-merchants and except managing agents.
12. To carry on the business of importers and exporters of all kinds of goods, commodities and merchandise of any nature or kind within the limits of the Memorandum.
- ~~13. To carry on the business of cold storage, manufacturer of ice, preservation of fruits, vegetables, fish meat, medicines and food products of all kinds and like commodities.~~
14. To establish and carry on all or any of the business of farmers, dairymen, milk contractors dairy farmers, millers, purveyors and vendors of milk, cream, cheese butters, poultry, provisions of all kinds, growers of and dealers in wheat, rice, corn, hay and straw seedmen, and miserymen and to buy, sell and trade in any goods usually traded in any of the above business.
15. To act as contractors or sub-contractors of Civil and Military Departments, District Councils, Municipal Corporations, Railways, Port Trust or other departments of Central and Provincial Governments for the supply of articles.
16. To enter into partnership arrangements in the nature of partnership, co-operation or union of interest with any person or persons, firms, of company engaged or interested in or about to become engaged or interested in the carrying on or conduct of and business or enterprise which this Company is authorized to carry on.
17. To draw make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bill of exchange, warrants, debentures and other negotiable or transferable instruments for company's business within the limits of its Memorandum of Association and excepting banking business.
18. To borrow or raise money be means of loans from Commercial Banks and Government Financial Institutions for company's trading or manufacturing business in particular by the issue of debentures or debenture stock perpetual or otherwise and to secure the re-payment of any money borrowed or raised mortgage charge on lien upon the undertaking, and the whole or any part of Company's property or assets whether present or future and also by a similar mortgage charge or lien so secured and guarantee the performance by the Company or any obligation or liability it may undertake.
19. To remunerate any person or company for services rendered or to be rendered in placing or assisting to place or guaranteeing the placing or under writing of any of the shares in the Company's capital or any debentures or debenture stock or other securities of the company in or about the formation or promotion of the company or the conduct of its business.
20. To Pay out of the funds of the company all expenses which the Company may lawfully pay off or incidental to the formation and advertising.
21. To enter into any arrangement with any Government or authority supreme, municipal or local and to obtain from any such Government authorities any rights, concessions or privileges that may seem conducive to the attainment of this Company's objects or any of them.

22. To distribute among the members of the Company, in kind, any of the property of the Company as permissible under law.
 23. To adopt such means of making known the business and products of company by advertising in the press.
 24. To appoint legal and technical advisers, and to appoint banker or bankers for the Company, and to pay the necessary expenses for the same.
 25. To create depreciation fund, sinking fund, insurance fund or any special or other fund for depreciation, or for repairing, improving, extending or maintaining any of the property of the Company.
 26. It is declared that notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing objects clauses of this Memorandum of Association, nothing contained therein shall be construed as empowering the company to undertake or indulge into the business of a banking company; banking investment, leasing or insurance business as restricted by law or any unlawful operation.

**ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION
OF
ITTEHAD (PRIVATE) LIMITED.**

PRELIMINARY

1. The regulations contained in Table 'A' in the first schedule to the Companies Ordinance, 1984 as amended up-to-date shall, subject as hereinafter appearing apply to the Company as for the same are applicable to private Companies.

PRIVATE COMPANY

2. The Company is a Private limited Company within the meaning of Section 2 (1) (28) of the Companies Ordinance, 1984 and accordingly:
 - (a) No invitation shall be issued to the public to subscribe for any shares, debentures or debenture stock of the company.
 - (b) The number of members of the Company (exclusive of the persons in the employment of the Company) shall be limited to fifty, provided that for the purposes of this provision where two or more persons hold one or more shares jointly in the Company, they shall be treated as single member; and
 - (c) The right of transfer shares in the Company is restricted in the manner and to the extent hereinafter appearing.

BUSINESS

3. The business of the Company shall include all or any of the objects enumerated in the Memorandum of Association and can be commenced immediately after the incorporation of the Company notwithstanding that a part of the capital has been subscribed.
4. The business of the Company will be carried out at such place or places in the whole of PAKISTAN or elsewhere as the Directors may deem proper or advisable from time to time.
5. The authorized Capital of the Company is Rs.1,050,000,000/- (Rupees One Billion Fifty Million Only) divided into 10,500,000 (Ten Million Five Hundred Thousand) ordinary shares of Rs.100/- each with powers to increase, reduce, consolidate or otherwise reorganize the share capital and to divide the shares of the Company into several classes in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2017.
6. The shares shall be under the control of the Directors who may allot or otherwise dispose of the same to such persons, firms, corporation or corporations at such terms and conditions and at such time as may be thought fit either at par or at premium or at discount as the Directors may think fit, subject to any permission required by law.
7. The shares in the capital of the Company may be allotted or issued in payment of any property, land, machinery or goods supplied or any services rendered to the Company in promotion or formation of the Company or conduct of its business and any shares so allotted may be issued as fully paid shares.

CERTIFICATES

8. Every person whose name is entered as a member in the Register of members shall without payment, be entitled to a certificate under the Common Seal of the Company specifying the share of shares held by several persons. The company shall not be bound to issue more than one certificate, and delivery of the share certificate to any one of the several joint holders shall be sufficient delivery to all.

TRANSFER AND TRANSMISSION OF SHARES

9. The Directors may decline to register any transfer of shares and may refuse to register any transfer to transferee of whom they do not approve and shall not be bound to show any reason for exercising their discretion. The Directors may also decline to transfer any share, the registration of which will involve a contravention of clause 2 of these presents.
10. No fee shall be charged for any transfer if approved by the Directors.
11. In case the Directors refuses to register a transfer of any shares, they shall within thirty days from the date on which the instrument to transfer was lodged with the Company give to the transferor and the transferee the notice of refusal as required by sub-section (1) of Section 78 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984.
12. No shares can be mortgaged, pledged, sold, hypothecated, transferred or disposed by any member to a non-member, without previous sanction of Directors.
13. The legal heirs, executors or administrators of a deceased holder of shares shall be the only persons to be recognize by the Directors as having title to the share in case of shares registered in the name of two or more holders the survivors and the executors of the deceased shall be the only persons to be recognized by the Company as having any title to the shares.

GENERAL MEETING

14. The annual general Meeting of the Company shall be held according to the provisions of section 158 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984 and the Directors may, whenever they think fit, call an extra-ordinary general meeting of the share-holders, members representing at least an one-teach of the voting power, for the time being may also in accordance with Section 159 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984, convene such meeting. Any requisition made by such shareholders shall express the objects of meeting proposed to be called and be left at the registered office of the company.

PROCEEDINGS AT GENERAL MEETINGS

15. 21 days notice at least specifying the place, day and the hour of general meeting and in case of special business the general nature of such business, shall be given to the members in the manner as may be prescribed by the Companies in general meeting but accidental omission to give such notice to or non-receipts of such notice by the member shall not invalidate the proceedings of the general meeting
16. The Chairman, with consent of any meeting at which a quorum is present (and shall if so directed by the meeting) may adjourn the meeting from time to time and from place to place, but no business shall be transacted at any adjourned meeting other than the business left unfinished at the meeting from which the adjournment took place.

QUORUM

17. No business shall be transacted at any general meeting unless a quorum of members is present at the time when the meeting proceeds to business save as herein otherwise provided. Two members, present in person holding not less than 25 % of the total voting power either on their own account or through proxies, shall form a quorum for a general meeting.

VOTES OF MEMBERS

18. Subject to any rights or restrictions for the time being attached to any class or classes of shares, on a show of hands every member present in person shall have one vote except for election of directors in which case the provisions of section 178 shall apply. On a poll every member shall have voting rights as laid down in section 160.
19. On a show of hands every member present in person shall have one vote and on a poll, every member shall, whether present in person or by proxy, have one vote in respect of each share held by him.
20. In case of an equality of votes, whether on a show of hands or on a poll, the Chairman of the meeting at which the show of hands, takes place, or at which the poll is demanded shall be entitled to a second or casting vote.
21. The instrument appointing a proxy and the power of attorney or other authority if any under which it is signed or notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority shall be deposited at the registered office of the company not less than forty- eight hours before the time for holding the meeting at which the person named, in the instrument proposes to vote. And in default, the instrument of proxy will not be treated as valid. No person shall act as proxy unless he is a member of the Company.
22. (a) Unless otherwise determined the number of Directors shall not be less than two and not more than eleven.
- (b) Till the Directors are elected at first annual general meeting the following person will act as First Directors of the Company.

23. The Directors of the Company shall be elected by the members of the Company in general meeting in the following manner namely subject to the provision of Section 178 of the Companies Ordinance 1984:
- (1) A member shall have such number of votes as is equal to the product of the number of voting shares or securities held by him and the number of directors to be elected:
 - (2) A member may give all his votes to a single candidate or divide them between more than one of the candidates in such manner as he may choose : and
 - (3) The candidate who gets the highest number of votes shall be declared elected as Director and then the candidate who gets the next highest number of votes shall be declared and so on until the total number of Directors to be elected have been so elected.

- (4) The Director including the Chief Executive shall hold office till the first Annual General Meeting unless he resigns earlier, becomes disqualified for being a Director or otherwise cease to hold office. Provided that a resolution for removing a director shall not be deemed to have been passed unless the number of votes cast in favour of such a resolution is not less than:-

REMOVAL OF DIRECTORS

24. A company may by resolution in general meeting remove a Director appointed under section 176 or section 180 or elected in the manner provided for in section 178.

Provided that a resolution for removing a director shall not be deemed to have been passed unless the number of votes cast in favour of such a resolution is not less than:-

- (I) The minimum number of votes that were cast for the election of a director at the immediately preceding election of director, if the resolution relates to removal of a director elected in the manner provided in sub-section (5) of section 178 : or
 - (II) The total number of votes for the time being computed in the manner laid down in sub-section (5) of section 178 divided by the number of directors for the time being, if the resolution relates to removal of a director appointed under section 176 or section 180.
25. The remuneration of Directors (excluding regularly paid Chief Executive & whole time working directors) shall from time to time determined by the Board of Directors, but it shall not exceed Rs. 500/ per meeting at which the Directors are present.
26. The Directors may sanction the payment of such additional sums as they may think fit to any director for any special service he may render to the company subject to the approval of the shareholders in the general meeting.
27. The Director who reside out of station shall also be entitled to be paid such travelling and other expenses for attending the meeting for the company as may be fixed by the Directors from time to time.
28. Any casual vacancy occurring among the Directors shall be filled in by a resolution of the Board of Directors and the persons so appointed shall hold office for the remainder of the terms of the Director in whose place he is appointed.
29. The quorum necessary for the transaction of the meeting of Board of Directors may be fixed by the Directors and unless so fixed, shall be two.
30. No Director shall be disqualified from his office by contracting with the Company either as vendor : Purchaser or otherwise nor shall any Director be liable to account for any profit realized from any such contract or arrangement or the fiduciary realised from any such contract or arrangement or the fiduciary relation thereby established by him at the first meeting of the Directors after acquisition.

MANAGEMENT

31. The business of the Company shall be managed by the Directors, who may pay all expenses incurred in getting up and registering the Company, and may exercise all such powers of the Company as or not, by the Company Ordinance 1984, or any statutory modification thereof for the time being in force, or by these articles required to be exercised by the Company in general meeting, subject nevertheless to any regulation of these Articles, to the provisions of the said act, and to such regulation being not inconsistent by the Company in general meeting: but no regulation made

by the company in general meeting shall invalidate any prior act of the Directors which would have been valid if that regulation had not been made.

32. The Chief Executive of the Company from the date of his appointment and will hold this post till the 1st annual general meeting or unless or until he becomes incapable for post for any reason. The said Chief Executive shall be paid such remunerations as may be decided by the Board of Directors from time to time and duly approved by General Body, subject to the provisions of the Companies Ordinance, 1984.
33. The Chief Executive may from time to time raise or borrow any sums of money for and on behalf of the company from the company or Banks or may himself advance to the company sums on such terms as may be approved by the Board of Directors, from time to time.
34. Without prejudice to the powers conferred to these Articles, the Chief Executive shall, subject to the supervision and control of Board of Directors, have the following powers:-
 - a) To pay the cost, charges and expenses preliminary and incidental to the promotion, establishment and registration of the company.
 - b) To take on lease, purchase or otherwise acquire for the company any property, movable or immovable, rights or privileges which the company is authorized to acquire at such price and generally on such terms and conditions as he may think fit.
 - c) To appoint any person or persons to hold in trust for any company any property belonging to the company or in which he is interested for any other purpose and execute and so all such instruments and things as may be requisite in relation any such trust.
 - d) To let, mortgage, sell, exchange or otherwise dispose of absolutely or conditionally all or any part of the privileges and undertaking of the company upon such terms and condition and for such consideration as he may think fit.
 - e) To buy or procure the supply or the plant, machinery, materials, stock-in-trade, stores, fuel, implements, immovable and other movable property required for the purpose of the company.
 - f) To sell, deal in and dispose of all articles and goods manufactured by the company.
 - g) To engage, fix and pay the remuneration of and dismiss or discharge all managers, agents, secretaries, clerks, servants, workmen and other persons employed in or in connection with the company's business.
 - h) To appoint any person or persons to be attorney or attorneys of the company for such purposes and with such powers, authorities and discretions and for such period and subject to such conditions as he may from time to time think fit.
 - i) To enter into, carry out, rescind, vary all financial arrangements with any bank, person or corporation of or in connection with such arrangements to deposit, pledge or hypothecate property of the Company or the documents representing or relating to the same.
 - j) To make and give receipts, release and discharge or all moneys payable to the company and for the claims and demands of the company.
 - k) For and on behalf of the company to draw, accept, endorse and negotiate all such cheques, bill, of exchange, promissory notes, hundies, drafts, Government and other securities as shall be necessary in or for carrying on the affairs of the company.
 - l) To compound or all allow time to the payments of satisfaction of any debts due to or by the Company and any claims and demands by or against the company and to refer any claims or demands by or against the company to arbitration and observe and perform, the award.
 - m) To institute, prosecute, compromise, withdraw or abandon any legal proceedings by or against the company of its officers or otherwise, concerning the affairs of the company.

- n) To deal with surplus moneys of the Company not immediately required for the purposes of the company upon such securities or investments and in such manner as he may think fit and from time to time to vary or realize such securities and investments but not to act as an investment company.
- o) To enter into such negotiation and contracts and rescind or vary all such contracts and execute and do all such acts, deeds and things in the name and on behalf of the company as he may consider expedient for or relation to any of the matters aforesaid or otherwise for the purposes of the company.
- p) To pay for any property or rights acquired by services rendered to the company or the Premiums payable in respect of any lease taken by the Company either wholly or partially in cash or in shares, bonds, debentures or other securities for the company and any such shares to be issued either as fully paid up and any such bond, debentures or securities to be either specially charged upon all or any part of the property of the company or not so charged.
- q) To give to any officer or other person employed by the company a commission on the profits of any particular business or transaction of the company and such commission shall be treated as a part of the working expenses of the company.
- r) To provide for the welfare of employees, or ex-employees of the company and the wives, windows or families or the dependents of such persons in such manner as he may think fit.
- s) To raise and borrow money from time to time for the purpose of the company, subject to the prior approval of the Directors on the mortgage of its property or any part thereof and either on any bond or debenture payable to bearer otherwise or on interest and payable in such a manner and generally upon such terms as he thinks fit.
- t) To delegate any of these powers to any person, agent or marfager as he thinks fit.
- u) To open in company name current accounts or letters of credit for any amount with any banks and to give instructions for operation of such accounts.
- v) Before re-recommending any dividend, to set aside out of the profits of the company, such sums as he may think proper for depreciation or special funds or reserve funds to meet the contingencies.
- w) To appear before any civil, criminal, revenue, excise income-tax and other authorities for and on behalf of the company and to sign any statement and documents, on behalf of the company and to sign Mukhtarnamas etc., on behalf of the company infavour of any person to represent defend and safeguard the interest of the company.

ACCOUNTS

35. The Directors shall cause to be kept proper books of accounts with respect to :
- a) All sums of money received and expended by the company and matter in respect of which the receipt and expenditure take place:
 - b) all sales and purchases of goods made by the company and:
 - c) all the assets and liabilities of the company:

Provided that all or any of the books of account aforesaid may be kept at such other place in Pakistan as the Directors may decide, and when the Directors so decide, the company shall within seven days of the decision, file with the Registrar a notice in writing giving the full address of the other place.

36. The books of account shall be kept at the registered office of the company or at such other place as the Directors shall think fit

AUDIT

37. The Auditors will be appointed every year and their duties regulated in accordance with section 252 to 255 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984.

THE SEAL

38. The Company shall have a common seal and the Directors shall provide for the safe custody of the same. The seal shall not be applied to any instrument except by the authority of the Board of Directors and in the presence of Chief Executive and another Director, who shall sign every instruments to which the seal shall be affixed in their presence. Such signatures shall be conclusive evidence of the fact that the seal has been properly affixed.

INDEMNITY

39. in connection with carrying on the business, every director, chief executive or other officers of the company shall be indemnified by the Company from all losses and expenses occasioned by and error of judgment or oversight or his part damage or misfortune whatsoever which happens in the execution of his duties of office unless the same happens though his own dishonesty or willful acts and defaults.

SECRECY

40. except as conferred by law, no member shall be entitled to visit or inspect the work of the Company without the permission of the Directors or to require discovery of any information regarding any details of the company's business or any matter which is or may be in the nature of trade secret, mystery or secret process which may relate to the conduct of the company's business and which in the opinion of Directors will be inexpedient in the interest of the members of the company to communicate to the public.

ARBITRATION

41. Whenever any difference arises between the company on the one hand and any of the members, their executors, administrators or assignees on the other hand, touching the true intent or construction or the incident or consequence of these presents or of the statutes or touching anything then or thereafter done executed omitted or suffered in pursuance of these presents or otherwise relating to the premises or to these presents or to any statute affecting the company or to any of the company every such difference shall be referred to the decision of the arbitrator or arbitrators or umpire under the Arbitration Act as amended.
42. The cost of any incidental to any such reference and award shall be of the discretion of the arbitrator or arbitrators or umpire, respectively who may determine the amount thereof and direct the same to be shared between the attorney and client or otherwise and may award by whom and in what manner the same shall be borne and paid.

WINDING UP

43. If the company is wound up whether voluntarily or otherwise the liquidator may, with the sanction of special resolution, divide among the contributors in specie the whole or any part of the assets of the company.

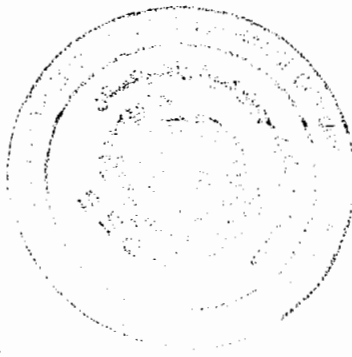

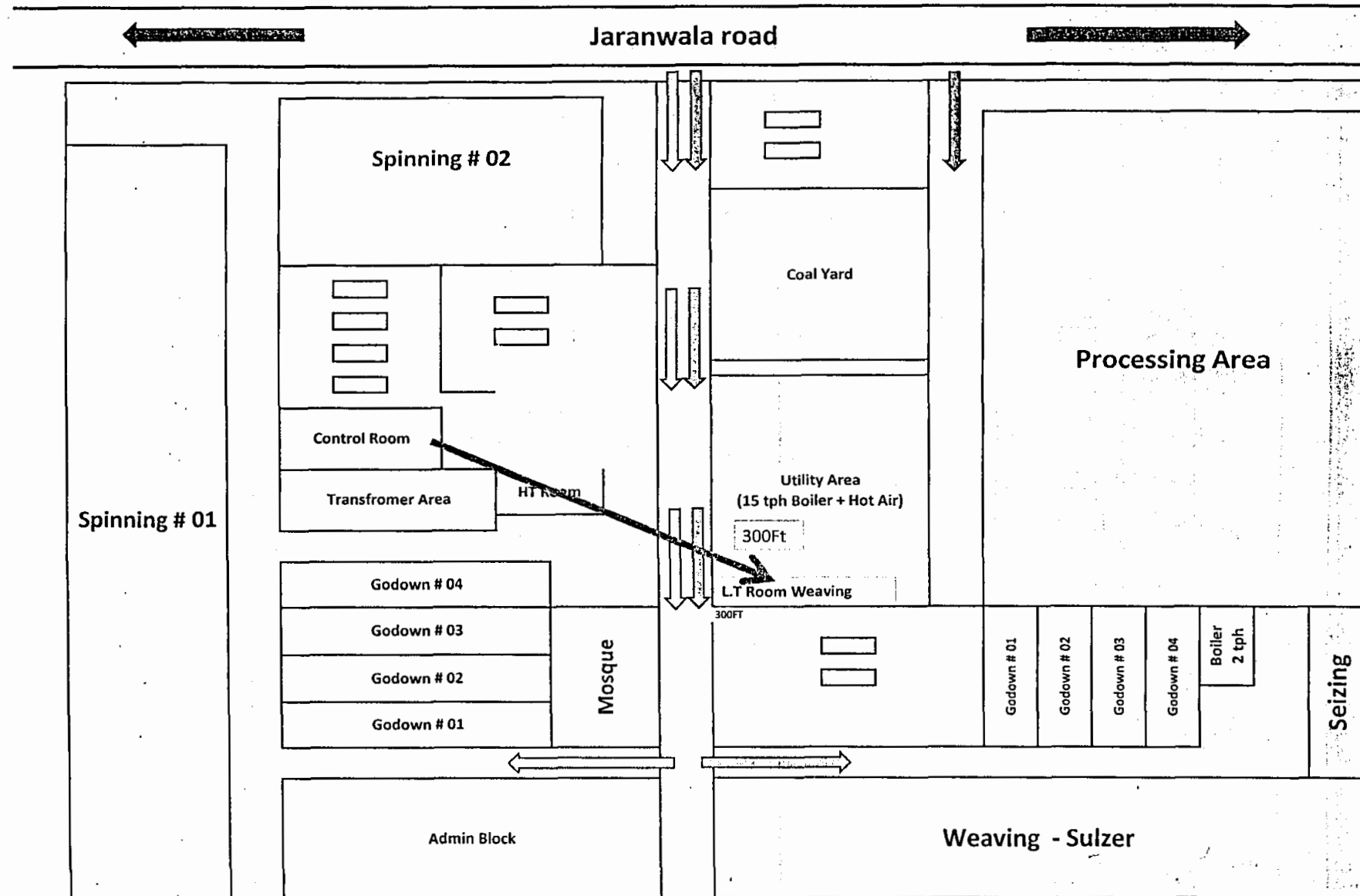
