

## **Instructions/Guidelines for orderly conduct of Hearing**

### **1. Submission of Comments/Objections:**

- Considering the volume of tasks at hand and to accommodate a large number of commentators, all interested persons desirous of furnishing any objections and comments related to the challenged determinations are encouraged to submit their comments/objections in writing before or on the date of hearing.

**Note:** To accommodate all the commentators, it is appreciated that comments/objections should be relevant to the Impugned Determinations and issues that have been conclusively decided by the NEPRA Appellate Tribunal and the Islamabad High Court may not be raised.

### **2. Right of Audience:**

- Commentators who have submitted written comments/objections will be given the first right of audience.
- Subsequently remaining commentators will be afforded an opportunity to ensure maximum participation during the hearing.

### **3. Participation Guidelines:**

- Online participants are requested to:
  - State their full name, CNIC, and details of the organization they represent (if any) before offering their comments.
  - Ensure their camera is switched on while offering comments.

### **4. Non-Adversarial Proceedings:**

- The proceedings will not be adversarial. Questions directed at any party during the hearing will not be allowed.
- The Authority will address all the comments and observations in its determination.
- All requests for information should be routed directly to the Government of Pakistan (GOP), CPPA-G, NTDC/NPCC, and DISCOs before the hearing date.

### **5. Housekeeping and Participation:**

- Participants who are physically present or joining online are requested to reach the NEPRA Hearing Hall or join the online session 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the hearing.
- This will enable NEPRA professionals to record the particulars of all the attendees and to moderate the hearing in an orderly manner.

### **6. Online Participation:**

- The proceedings will be conducted in a structured manner to ensure orderly participation. All participants are expected to follow the guidelines provided to maintain decorum during the hearing.
