#### **DECISION**

1. As per facts of the case, the respondent is an industrial consumer of K-Electric bearing Ref No.AP-078517 having a sanctioned load of 41 kW under B-2(b) tariff. The detection bill of Rs.567,340/- for3,220 units for the period 06.06.2015 to 04.12.2015 (6 months) was debited to the respondent by K-Electric @ 33% slowness of the meter as observed on 06.01.2016.K-Electric further charged two assessed bills to the respondent for January 2016 and March 2016. The respondent filed a complaint before the Provincial Office of Inspection, Karachi Region-II. Karachi (POI) and assailed the above billing, which was disposed of by POI vide decision dated 06.04.2016.

2. The aforesaid decision of POI was impugned by K-Electric vide the Appeal

No.091/POI-2016 before NEPRA, which was accepted by the NEPRA Appellate Board

vide its decision dated 04.11.2016, set aside the impugned decision and the matter was

remanded back to POI for an appropriate decision clearly mentioning the name of the

respondent.

3. Through the instant appeal, K-Electric again challenged the impugned decision dated

06.04.2016 before NEPRA. The notice was issued to both the parties and the hearing

was conducted at NEPRA regional office, Karachi on 11.03.2018, which was attended

only by the K-Electric officials. Representatives of K-Electric averred that POI vide its

letter No. EIK-II/8-II (002)/2016-316 dated 14.11.2016 clarified that the complaint was

filed by Mr. Abdul Rasheed, who is the proprietor of M/s. Ali Brothers. K-Electric

prayed for setting aside the impugned decision being devoid of merits.

4. Arguments heard and the record perused. It is observed that the impugned decision

dated 06.04.2016 has already been set aside by the NEPRA Appellate Board vide

decision dated 04.11.2016 and case was remanded back to POI but no fresh decision

was given by POI. Hence, the instant appeal filed by K-Electric against the same

impugned decision is not competent before NEPRA and dismissed, accordingly.
