K. Electric Limited through Mr. Asif Shajer, Deputy Manager (Regulations) of K-Electric Limited (hereinafter referred to as **"the Appellant"**) submitted the subject appeal titled "K-Electric Limited Vs Mst. Rukhsana" received in this office on 23.04.2019 (**PUC**). The subject appeal has been filed by K. Electric Limited against the decision of the Provincial Office of Inspection/Electric Inspector regarding Complaint of Mst. Rukhsana. The instant appeal has been filed under Section 38(3) of NEPRA Act against the decision dated 22.03.2019 of the Provincial Office of Inspection/Electric Inspector, Karachi Region-II. Karachi.

4. Pursuant to the Authority's approved functional process (ref: MOM of RM 13-187) for processing the appeals the steps from Regulation 3 to Regulation 10(1) of Regulations has been completed. As per the said functional process, after preparation of initial checklist, Registrar Office has to forward the case to the CAD for comments/recommendations regarding registration of the appeal (step ii of functional process in respect of Regulation 10(1) of the Regulations).
