### **APPEAL UNDER SECTION 38(3) OF REGULATION OF GENERATION, TRANSMISSION, AND DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC POWER ACT, 1997 AGAINST THE DECISION DATED 31.08.2020 PASSED BY PROVINCIAL OFFICE OF INSPECTION KARACHI REGION-II, KARACHI**

### **DECISION**

1. As per facts of the case, the Respondent is a commercial consumer of the K-Electric having Ref No.AP-081952 with sanctioned load of 10 kW and the applicable Tariff is A-2C. The Respondent filed an application before the Provincial Office of Inspection, Karachi Region-II, Karachi (the POI) and challenged the arrears of Rs.2,103,738/- till July 2020, which included the bills for the period February 2020 to July 2020 charged by the K-Electric. The POI inspected the premises of the Respondent on 02.07.2020 wherein the behavior of the billing meter of the Respondent was observed abnormal. The complaint of the Respondent was disposed of by the POI vide decision dated 09.01.2020, wherein the bills for the period December 2019 to July 2020 were cancelled and the K-Electric was directed to install a new meter and revise the bills

for the disputed period i.e. December 2019 to July 2020 based as per the average consumption of six months recorded by the new meter.

2. Instant appeal has been filed against the above-referred decision by the K-Electric before the NEPRA. After issuing notice, hearing of the appeal was held at the NEPRA Regional Office Karachi on 19.11.2021, which was attended by both the parties. During the arguments, both the parties mutually agreed in writing on the following actions to be taken by the K-Electric; (1) the bills for the period from December 2019 and onwards till the replacement of the defective meter will be revised on the basis of average consumption of the undisputed period i.e. April 2019 to November 2019; (2) the revised bills of the disputed period December 2019 and onwards till the replacement of the defective meter will be assessed as per the applicable tariff of the relevant months; (3) the payments made, if any, against the above disputed bills will be adjusted accordingly; and (4) the defective meter and the cable of the Respondent will be replaced within one (1) week.
3. In view of above, the K-Electric is therefore directed to implement the agreement between the parties as mentioned in the para 2 above.
4. The appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
