

### **DECISION**

1. Briefly speaking, Mr. Muhammad Saleem (hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent") is a domestic consumer of K-Electric (hereinafter referred to as the "Appellant") bearing Ref No. LB-314388 having sanctioned load of 01 kW and the applicable tariff category is A-1R. The Appellant charged a detection bill of Rs.125,654/- against 4,597 units for six months for the period from 22.12.2020 to 21.06.2021 to the Respondent on account of direct theft of electricity observed during site inspection dated 21.06.2021, which was challenged before the Provincial Office of Inspection Karachi Region-II, Karachi (the "POI"). The complaint of the Respondent was disposed of by

POI vide decision dated 18.10.2022 wherein the detection bill of Rs.125,654/- against 4,597 units for six months for the period from 22.12.2020 to 21.06.2021 was cancelled against which subject appeal has been filed by the Appellant before the NEPRA.

### 2. Hearing

Hearing was conducted at the NEPRA Regional Office Karachi on 05.05.2023 which was attended by both parties. At the outset of the hearing, the Appellant declared that the settlement of the disputed bill with the Respondent is under process and requested to dispose of the appeal after the submission of the settlement deed between parties. The Respondent appearing in person supported the contention of the Appellant regarding amicable settlement. Subsequently, the Appellant submitted an application dated 12.10.2023 for withdrawal of the subject appeal with the plea that the matter was amicably settled between the parties, as such the Appellant does not intend to press this Appeal anymore. In support of their contention, the Appellant placed a copy of the undertaking dated 04.10.2023 submitted by the Respondent regarding the amicable settlement of the disputed bill.

3. In view of the above statement, the appeal is disposed of as withdrawn.
