DECISION

- 1. As per the facts of the case, the Respondent, who is a commercial consumer of LESCO bearing Ref No.45-11541-0389009 approached the Provincial Office of Inspection Lahore Region, Lahore (the POI) and challenged the detection bill of Rs.222.376/- for 10.985 units charged by LESCO in July 2018. The application of the Respondent was decided by POI vide its decision dated 19.03.2019, wherein the above detection bill was declared as null and void.
- 2. Through the instant appeal, the POI decision dated 19.03.2019 has been impugned by the LESCO before the NEPRA. After issuing notice, hearing in the matter was conducted at the NEPRA Regional Office Lahore on 04.02.2022 which was attended

by learned counsel for the LESCO and no one appeared for the appeal. At the outset of the hearing, learned counsel for LESCO stated that LESCO did not intend to proceed with the appeal and prayed for its withdrawal.
