

DECISION

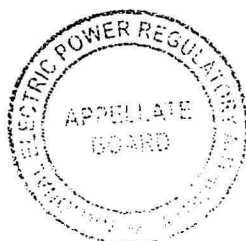
1. As per facts of the case, Abdul Malik (hereinafter referred to as the “Respondent”), who is a domestic consumer of Peshawar Electric Supply Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as the “Appellant”) bearing Ref No.02-26128-0680304-01 filed a complaint before the Provincial Office of Inspection, Peshawar Region, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (the “POI”) on 04.04.2019 and challenged the detection bill of Rs.134,050/- charged in January 2019. The complaint of the Respondent was disposed of by the POI vide decision dated 26.06.2019 against which the subject appeal was filed by the Appellant before the NEPRA.

2. Hearing

Hearing was conducted at the NEPRA Head Office Islamabad on 27.09.2023 in which the official of the Appellant appeared and the Respondent did not tender appearance. At the outset of the hearing, the Appellant declared that the matter of the disputed bill was amicably settled between

the parties, as such the Appellant does not intend to press this Appeal anymore. In support of his contention, the Appellant placed a copy of the affidavit submitted by the Respondent regarding the amicable settlement of the disputed bill.
