#### Decision

Through this decision, a motion for leave for review filed by K-Electric Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Petitioner" or "KE") against the decision of NEPRA Regional Office Karachi dated November 22, 2024 in the matter of complaint of Mr. Imran Ali (hereinafter referred to as the "Complainant") against K-Electric Limited filed under Section 39 Of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (hereinafter referred to as the "NEPRA Act"), is being disposed of.

2. Brief facts of the case are that NEPRA received a complaint wherein the dispute agitated by the Complainant was that KE has charged excessive bill for the month of July 2024 and requested NEPRA to intervene in the matter and direct KE to revise the excessive

- As per tariff notified vide SRO.1035(1)/2024; month or billing period unless iv. otherwise defined for any particular tariff category means a billing month of 31 days or less reckoned from the date of last meter reading. Moreover, the said SRO has been effective since July 1, 2024.
- KE has charged bill to the Complainant for the month of July 2024 with meter v. reading date as July 08, 2024 for 31 days period as meter reading for the month of June 2024 was carried by KE on June 07, 2024.
- KE has charged bill to the Complainant for the month of July 2024 in line with vi. the provision defined in the above mentioned SRO.

6. Foregoing in view, the decision of NEPRA Regional Office, Karachi dated November 22, 2024 is modified and it is held that the bill for the month of July 2024 charged by KE to the Complainant is justified. Further proceedings in the matter are being closed by this office.
