This decision shall dispose of the complaint filed by Mr. Ayaz Mahmood (hereinafter referred to as "the Complainant") against Lahore Electric Supply Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Respondent" or "LESCO"), under Section 39 of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 (hereinafter referred to as the "NEPRA Act").

2. The Complainant in his complaint submitted that LESCO has charged excessive bills to him as compared to actual meter reading at site. Accordingly, the matter was taken up with LESCO and a hearing was held on October 3, 2023 at NEPRA Provincial Office, Lahore. The hearing was attended by both the parties (i.e. LESCO and the Complainant) wherein the matter was discussed in detail. During the hearing, it revealed that the Complainant was being charged with excessive billing. The Complainant was charged upto 2664 kWh, Off-peak & 171 kWh, Peak reading index upto the month of September, 2023 whereas the actual meter reading as per snap of September, 2023 was 791 kWh, Off-peak & 171 kWh, Peak which shows that the Complainant was charged 1873 Off-peak units excessively. Sanctioned Load of the Consumer is 6 kW. Clause 6.1.2 and Clause 6.2.1 of Consumer Service Manual (CSM) provides that Meter Reader and Meter Reading Section Supervisor/LS are responsible for meter reading of such consumers and percentage checking respectively. The Complainant was charged excessive billing due to sheer negligence of concerned Meter Reader and Line Superintendent.
