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

**DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF TARIFF PROPOSAL
SUBMITTED BY FRONTIER POWER SHOGO-SIN (PVT) LIMITED FOR 137 MW
HYDROPOWER PROJECT.**

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 Frontier Power Shogo-Sin (Pvt) Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the "Company or FPSH"), envisages to set up an 137 MW run-of-the-river, high head hydro power project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project") on Lutkho River near Shogo Village, District Upper Chitral, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

1.2 The company filed a Tariff Petition for determination of tariff for the Project pursuant to rule 3 of the National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (Tariff Standards and Procedures) Rules, 1998.

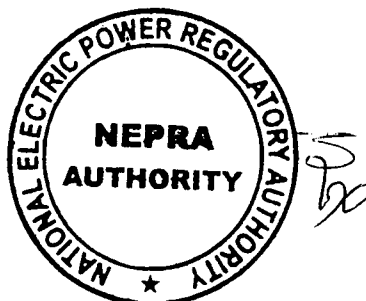
2. Proceedings:

2.1 Frontier Power Shogo-Sin (Pvt.) Ltd (FPSH) vide letter dated 09.08.2019 has submitted an application for Generation License and petition for determination of EPC stage tariff for its 137 MW Shogo-Sin Hydropower Project. The Authority considered its application for Generation License and directed to ensure completion of required documents for license. Due to non-availability of Grid Interconnection Study (GIS); the Authority vide letter dated October 17, 2019 rejected the generation license for FPSH for failure to fulfill the mandatory requirements for grant of license.

3. Finding of the Authority:

3.1 The Authority observed that the application of FPSH for grant of Generation Licensee was rejected due to non-availability of GIS and accordingly the tariff petition of the Company is also liable to be dismissed due to license issue. In terms of Section 14(B) read with Section 2(x) of NEPRA Act, no person shall, except under the authority of license issued by the Authority under the Act and subject to the conditions specified in the Act and as may be imposed by the Authority construct, own or operate a generation facility.


3.2 Further in terms of proviso to rule 16(2) of NEPRA Tariff (Standards & Procedure) Rules, 1998, in case of failure of any person to comply with directions of the Authority to provide any information or documents, the Authority may either dismiss the petition or may proceed to decide on the basis of available information.





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
3.3 In the light of the above discussion and analysis, the Authority has decided to dismiss the petition, however, the Company may file the petition after fulfillment of deficiencies and in the manner prescribed in law.




