Request for Quarterly Adjustment in its Tariff for the Quarter ended December 2014 was communicated to the Federal Government for notification in the official Gazette.

The subject Decision of the Authority is being intimated to the Federal Government for the purpose of notification in the official Gazette pursuant to Section 31 (4) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act (XL of 1997) and Rule 16(11) of the National Electric Power Regulatory Authority Tariff (Standards and Procedure) Rules, 1998.

DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION FILED BY MINISTRY OF WATER AND POWER REGARDING DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY FOR QUARTERLY ADJUSTMENT OF TARIFF OF K-ELECTRIC LIMITED (K-ELECTRIC) FOR THE QUARTER ENDED DECEMBER, 2014

- Pursuant to section 31(4) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 and in accordance with the determination of the National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority") in case No. NEPRA/TRF-133/KESC-2009(6) dated December 23, 2009 notified vide S.R.O. No. 11(1)/2010 dated January 01, 2010, K-Electric Limited (hereinafter referred to as "K-Electric") has been allowed quarterly adjustments in its tariff.
- 2. In accordance with the aforementioned determination, the Authority decided adjustments and issued Schedule of Tariff (hereinafter referred to as "SoT") of K-Electric for the quarter ended December, 2014 through decision no. NEPRA/TRF-133/KESC-2009/8974-8977 dated June 10, 2015. The mentioned decision was intimated to the Ministry of Water and Power (MoW&P) for the purpose of notification in the official gazette pursuant to Section 31(4) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act (XL of 1997).
- 3. In addition to cost adjustments, the Authority also decided to pass on claw back amount of Ps. 42/ kWh directly to the consumers, calculated for the results reported by K-Electric for the financial year 2014. This amount was worked out in accordance with the Claw Back Mechanism ("CBM") prescribed vide Authority's determination dated December 23, 2009.
- 4. However, the said decision was challenged by K-Electric before Honorable High Court of Sindh ("SHC") vide Suit No. 989/2015 dated June 11, 2015. Earlier, SHC through order dated June 11, 2015 restrained MoW&P from issuing subject quarter's SoT. Later, SHC on January 26, 2016 decided, inter alia, that the defendants (NEPRA & MoW&P) may not implement CBM.
- 5. Referring the aforementioned order of SHC, K-Electric on January 28, 2016 wrote to NEPRA to issue the pending SoT pertaining to the quarter ended December, 2015. The Authority vide its letter dated March 15, 2016 sent the aforementioned SHC's order to MoW&P for further necessary action in this regard.



- 6. Accordingly, MoW&P vide its letter dated March 28, 2016 received in this office on March 29, 2016 filed a reconsideration request on the subject quarterly adjustment decision. Along with that request, MoW&P communicated subsidy numbers to be incorporated in SoT of the mentioned decision.
- One error was identified in the aforementioned request which was communicated to the concerned official of MoW&P. In response, that error was rectified and a new corrected SoT was forwarded by MoW&P vide letter dated April 06, 2016.
- 8. The Authority noted that the reconsideration request does not require any modification or revision in the NEPRA determined rates and the said request is made by the MoW&P to incorporate the category wise subsidy allowed by the Government of Pakistan ("GOP") to maintain uniform tariff across the country. The Authority considered the revised reconsideration request and decided to admit the same for further processing.
- 9. During the processing, it was noted that no surcharges was indicated by MoW&P to equalize the tariff for few categories in the SoT in which applicable tariff was higher than NEPRA's determined tariff. However, the Authority noted that providing subsidy and imposing surcharges is the prerogative of the GOP, therefore, decided to further process the submitted reconsideration request as such. Nevertheless, K-Electric is hereby directed to adjust over/under recovered amount (difference in approved and actually charged tariffs) in the future bills of the respective consumer categories. For that purpose, K-Electric shall submit a schedule of adjustment to the Authority and upon doing so shall also certify the Authority and MoW&P of the same.

Inadvertent Error

10. It is important to mention here that the Authority corrected an inadvertent error of Ps. 14/ kWh in the SoT of K-Electric through decision dated March 31, 2014. K-Electric challenged the said decision in Honorable High Court of Sindh by virtue of which the mentioned decision of the Authority was suspended to the extent of rectification of Ps 14/ kWh in K-Electric's SoT. In view hereof, the impact of rectified error has not been subtracted from the tariff indicated in the attached SoT.



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Decision

11. The revised SoT is being intimated to the Federal Government for notification in the official gazette in terms of Section 31(4) of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act (XL of 1997) and Rule 16(11) of the National Electric Power Regulatory Authority Tariff (Standards and Procedure) Rules, 1998. The amount of tariff differential subsidy already been paid by GOP to K-Electric, if any, may be adjusted in view of the attached SOT.
