ISSUES FRAMED FOR HEARING SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 14, 2016
IN THE MATTER OF FEASIBILITY STAGE TARIFF PETITION FILED BY
KANDIAH HYDROPOWER (PVT) LIMITED FOR ITS 545 MW KAIGAH HYDROPOWER
PROJECT (Case No.NEPRA/TRF-334/KHPL-2015)

- i) Whether the project satisfies the limits proposed under the NEPRA (Interconnection Facilities for Renewable Generation Facilities) Regulation, 2015 and whether the interconnection study has been approved by the power purchaser?
- ii) Whether the petitioner holds a valid letter of intent (LOI) issued by the relevant agency?
- iii) Whether the revised project design has been approved by the relevant agency?
- iv) Whether the capacity, hydrology, net annual energy generation, auxiliary consumption and plant factor claimed by the petitioner are justified and whether the latest hydrological data has been accounted for calculation of energy and capacity?
- v) Whether the EPC cost claimed by the petitioner is justified?
- vi) Whether the cost sharing mechanism of access road infrastructure to project/Kandiah valley with the owner agency of Dasu hydropower project as recommended in the feasibility study has been addressed with the relevant agency?
- vii) Whether the cost of custom duty claimed in the EPC cost as well as Non-EPC cost, is justified?
- viii) Whether the engineering & supervision cost claimed by the petitioner, is justified?
- ix) Whether the project development cost claimed by the petitioner, is justified?
- x) Whether the insurance during construction cost claimed by the petitioner, is justified?
- xi) Whether the project construction period claimed by the petitioner, is justified?
- xii) Any other issue with the approval of the Authority.
