Dear Sir,

This is further to our letter dated 29th March 2018.

We refer to revised clause 3.3 of the PAC advised in your letter No. NEPRA/C(Hydro)/PAR-168/4860 dated 26 March 2018 which is a follows:

"The fuel for the Facility shall be indigenous natural gas. In the event that the supply of indigenous gas to the Facility is discontinued by SSGC during the Term and SSGC commits to replace indigenous gas with RLNG, LCPL shall, in consultation with KE, apply to NEPRA for prior permission to use RLNG as fuel and for determination of a new fuel price for RLNG and a revised thermal efficiency as determined by NEPRA."

We would like to submit that Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (SSGC) has informed LCPL vide letter no. Sales/RLNG/PG-1421 dated 22 November 2017 (copy attached) that from December 2017 onwards, LCPL will be billed on RLNG tariff for use of fuel for generation of surplus power to sell to K Electric.

As informed by SSGC and advised by NEPRA under revised clause 3.3 of the PAC, we hereby seek your permission to use RLNG as fuel to generate surplus power to sell to K Electric. Please note that as per understanding with SSGC there will be no change in our gas quality or connection, simply the additional gas drawn for the sale of power will be swap gas which will be billed at RLNG price. Therefore, thermal efficiency will remain the same.
